School Tours

- School tours serves approximately 25,000 people a year
- Age 4 through grade 12
- October through May
- Tours are docent led
- Visit the website for menu of tour options

Art Around the Corner (AAC): Partnership with DCPS

- Multiple-visit program for 4th and 5th grade students and their teachers
- 5 museum visits, 1 classroom visit, and a Family Day at the Gallery
- NGA provides classroom materials, teacher training workshops, and buses
- Goals:
 1. deepen understanding of art
 2. strengthen critical thinking skills
 3. expand world views



High School Programs

- High School Seminar 2.0
- Studio Workshops
- Advanced Workshops
 - Art History
 - US History
 - European History



Teacher Programs

- Saturday and after-school workshops for local educators (Pre-School through Grade 12, all subject areas, and administrators)
- Two six-day National Teacher Institutes each summer
- Provides resources to help teachers find meaning in the visual arts by introducing the Gallery's collection and exhibitions, exploring interdisciplinary curriculum connections, and modeling methods for teaching with art.



Family and Teen Programs

- Learning that takes place outside the context of school
- Free, public programs
- Serve between 10,000-20,000 visitors a year in on-site, educator-led programs



Family Programs

- Family audiences are multi-generational learning groups: children ages 4 – 12 with their adult companions (parents, grandparents, other relatives or caretakers)
- Families want to enjoy the museum through a variety of program formats: storytelling, theatrical performances, films, music performances, self-guiding materials, audio tours, family days, and studio workshops



Developmental spectrum:

- ***Stories in Art (4-7 years)***
- ***Artful Conversations (8-11 years)***
- ***Family Workshops (8-11 years)***
- ***Tween Workshops (grades 7-9)***
- ***Teen Studio Workshops (grades 10-12)***

Auditorium Programs (reduced due to EBLA closure):

- **Film Program for Children and Teens**
(will resume this summer!!)
 - **Family Concerts**
 - **Special Performances (plays, storytellers)**
- Participation is on a **first-come, first-served** basis on the day of the program.
- **Age range varies** depending upon program.

Multiple-visit family programs for local audiences:

- Learning how to look
- One work of art
- Annual attendance is about 10,000 participants
- Participation is on a first-come, first-served basis on the day of the program. Participants sign-in at a registration table managed by Family Programs staff.
- Presented as a series of 6 topics a year for each age group; 8 years; for a total family “curriculum” of 48 different topics

Stories in Art (4-7 years)

Artful Conversations (8-11 years)

Studio Workshops

- Combine looking (art history) and making (studio art), each informing the other
- Begin and end in the Studio, includes visit to the galleries (all Studio programs require advance online registration; not a drop-in space)
- Annual attendance is about 2,000 participants (more intimate)
- Advance registration required. Online registration at the beginning of each program season. Extremely popular: must be online at exact time posted.

Family Workshops (8-11 years)

Tween Workshops (grades 7-9, this year start and end in the Founders' Room)

Teen Studio (grades 10-12)

Teen Programs

- Learning that takes place outside the context of school for tweens (grades 7-9) and teens (grades 10-12) who are interested in art



- Programs combine art history (in the galleries), studio art (in the Studio), and behind-the-scenes tours to learn about the museum and explore careers

- Teen Volunteers and Studio Assistants
