Eligibility

Eligibility varies according to internship. A few are geared to undergraduates graduating in spring 2015, but most are for currently enrolled graduate students of all levels and those graduating in spring 2015 with a relevant degree (such as MA, MBA, MFA, M Arch, M Ed, JD, or MLS). Please check prerequisites carefully. Applicants from all backgrounds are encouraged to apply. This is an international program.
