**Abstract** This collection documents the activities of Dorothy and Herbert Vogel as

collectors of minimal and contemporary art and their relationship with art institutions, artists, dealers, curators, scholars, and other individuals in the art world. Materials consist of correspondence; checklists, object lists, and inventories; invoices and financial documents; photographs; audiovisual recordings; newspaper clippings; posters; invitations and greeting cards; monographs and exhibition catalogs; and non-accessioned works of art.

### **Biographical Note**

For over five decades, Herbert and Dorothy Vogel inspired the art world with their modest backgrounds, their unconventional art collecting methods, and their close relationships with artists. For most of his life, Herb worked for the United States Postal Service in New York City and Dorothy was a librarian for the Brooklyn Public Library. They shared a passion for collecting minimal and conceptual art. The couple developed their own unique method of collecting art which suited their abiding interest in the creation of contemporary art on their modest income. After giving up their own early artistic pursuits, the Vogels spent their free time methodically visiting museums and galleries throughout New York City, befriending artists and touring their studio spaces, and regularly acquiring works of art directly from artists. They sometimes made

purchases on credit or payment plans, and even occasionally exchanged pet-sitting services for works of art.

As a result, over a fifty-year period from 1962-2012, the Vogels amassed an impressive collection of over 4,000 works of art primarily on paper, with a focus on minimal and conceptual art. The Vogels stored their collection in a one-bedroom Manhattan apartment that they shared with their pets and where they hosted many visitors, including artist friends, museum professionals, and international art figures.

The Vogels began lending their collection to art exhibitions in the 1970s which furthered their reputation as astute collectors. By the late 1980s, their collection had expanded to such an extent that the Vogels initiated plans for donating their works of art. Courted by many institutions, the Vogels ultimately chose the National Gallery of Art (NGA). They were drawn to the Gallery's dedication to public service, free admission, and its practice of barring sale of donated works of art. These characteristics appealed to the Vogels as art collectors and as retired public servants.

Due to the enormity of their collection, the Vogels developed a national gift distribution program in association with NGA to share their works of art with varied communities and to increase art appreciation across the country. The initiative, *Dorothy and Herbert Vogel Collection: Fifty Works for Fifty States* (Vogel 50x50), identified fifty art institutions in each US state to receive a gift of fifty works of art from the Vogel collection.

The Vogels continued to collect art after their initial donation to NGA in 1992. Their collection had doubled from 2,400 to approximately 4,000 works of art at the time of Herb's death in 2012. Their collection was donated eventually to NGA and museums throughout the United States as part the Vogel 50x50 project and other gifts.

An appendix Timeline of Major Events relating to the Vogels and their collection follows the box inventory.

### **Scope and Content**

The papers document the activities of Dorothy and Herbert Vogel as collectors of minimal and contemporary art and their relationship with artists, dealers, curators, and people in the art field as well as their association with museums, especially the National Gallery of Art (NGA). The materials in the collection span the years 1948–2020 (bulk 1962–2004). They consist of non-accessioned works of art, artists' books, correspondence, newspaper clippings, monographs, photographs (prints, negatives, and 35mm slides), video tapes, audio tapes and reels, monographs, exhibition catalogs, inventory and object lists, legal and financial records, posters, and other documentary materials.

While the papers focus primarily on the Vogels' art collecting activities and their interactions with friends and individuals in the art world, there are materials relating to their personal lives and

family. Major life events, such as the couple's birthdays, Dorothy's retirement, and Herb's death, are documented in this collection. The papers include non-accessioned paintings by the Vogels. Of special interest are birthday cards, postcards, greeting cards, and envelopes addressed to the Vogels from their artist friends—some of them containing drawings, sketches, and doodles by the senders.

Information about the Vogel's association with NGA and their work for *The Dorothy and Herbert Vogel Collection: Fifty Works for Fifty States* (Vogel 50x50) project is also included.

### **Series Descriptions**

#### Series 1 Artist Postcards and Other Works, circa 1970–2009 [boxes 1–3]

Arranged alphabetically by artist. This series includes postcards, artists books and non-accessioned works of art sent or given to the Vogels from various artists. Artists include Dorothy Alexander, Will Barnet, Robert Barry, Michael Vinson Clark, Charles Clough, Claudia Delmonte, Richard Francisco, Ray Johnson, Sol LeWitt, Michael Lucero, Robert Mangold, Lucio Pozzo, Edda Renouf, Eve Sonneman, Richard Tuttle, and others. These materials document the personal and close relationship between the Vogels and their artist friends.

The series also includes a plaster bust of Herb Vogel by John Forgione, several canvas paintings of the Vogels' cat, Archie, and other animals by Eric Ginsberg, and three-dimensional objects by Nick Agid. Of special interest are two pieces of fabric used in Christo and Jean Claude's installation, *The Gates* in New York City's Central Park, and signed by Christo. Other pieces of fabric from the installation are in Series 2.

Some materials in this series may be restricted due to personally identifiable information.

Some artist postcards have been digitized and are available to researchers. Select digitized postcards may be found, in association with artist biographies, on the Vogel 50x50 website.

#### Series 2 Correspondence, 1962–2020 [boxes 1–8]

Arranged alphabetically by correspondent. This series consists primarily of incoming correspondence to the Vogels from friends, collectors, dealers, museum staff, and family members. Correspondents include artists, such as Christo and Jeanne-Claude, Will Barnet, Clark Fox, Don Hazlitt, Sol LeWitt, Robert Mangold, Edda Renouf and Richard Tuttle, and National Gallery of Art curators, such as Mary Lee Corlett, Jack Cowart, Molly Donovan, Ruth Fine, and Carlotta Owens. The majority of the correspondence is comprised of birthday wishes, holiday greetings, wedding and birth announcements, photographs, and invitations to exhibition openings and other events. The materials represent the personal relationship between the Vogels and their art friends and colleagues. Of interest is a folder of outgoing letters drafted by Dorothy to several individuals. There are also two folders containing unidentified correspondence.

The series also contains several letters from emerging artists with requests for the Vogels to include their art in their collection. Of special interest is the Kimmelman family correspondence which includes two small pieces of fabric used by Christo and Jeanne-Claude in their installation *The Gates* in New York City. Other pieces of fabric from the installation are in Series 1.

#### Series 3 Exhibition Files, 1970–2015 [boxes 1–5]

Arranged chronologically by exhibition opening date. This series documents exhibitions that included works of art from the Vogel collection. Materials primarily consist of exhibition catalogs, object lists, newspaper clippings, correspondence, invitations, announcements, checklists, condition reports, legal documents, photographs, and itineraries. There are two folders relating to a cancelled show at the Brooklyn Museum in the late 1980s.

Materials relating to exhibitions that did not include the Vogel collection are in Series 4 Subject Files.

#### Series 4 Subject Files, 1950–2019 [boxes 1–9]

Arranged alphabetically. This series contains materials relating to the Vogels and their biography, including information about their speaking engagements, film documentaries, and interviews as well as references to the artists in their collection. Materials consist of newspaper clippings, print material, photographs, copies of deeds of gift, correspondence, and guest books. Also included are several folders containing announcements and invitations to exhibition openings that did not include works from the Vogel collection. Of particular note is information about the screenings of two film documentaries *Herb & Dorothy and Herb & Dorothy 50x50* and their associated events.

The series also includes condolence cards, eulogies, obituaries, and a guest book relating to Herb's passing in 2012. Of special interest is an undated poem titled "The Library" written for Dorothy by American novelist and playwright Norman Rosten.

#### Series 5 National Gallery of Art Files, 1968–1991 [boxes 1–4]

Arranged alphabetically. This series focuses on the Vogels' relationship with the National Gallery of Art (NGA) and documents their gifts, loans, exhibitions, events, and visits to the museum.

Materials include correspondence, object lists, photographs, travel itineraries, loan calendars, and conservation reports. Of special interest are inventories of works of art in the Vogel apartment for transfer to NGA, notes by NGA curator Jack Cowart, and press materials about the donation.

Information about the Vogel 50x50 project can be found in Series 6.

### Series 6 50x50 Project Files, 2001–2019 [boxes 1–5]

Arranged alphabetically by state. The series documents the planning, development, and implementation of *The Dorothy and Herbert Vogel Collection: Fifty Works for Fifty States* (Vogel 50x50) project. Materials consist of correspondence, the proposal, distribution recommendations, invitations, catalogs, object lists, and publicity ephemera from recipient institutions. Related materials can be found in RG50 Vogel 50x50 Project.

### Series 7 Object Cards and Files, 1967–2011 [boxes 1–4]

Arranged alphabetically by artist. This series consists of 3" x 5" index cards and files documenting the provenance of works of art in the Vogel collection. Information includes title of the work, artist, dimensions, medium, and other cataloging data. Most of the index cards were handwritten by Dorothy and some of them include 35mm slides of images of the work of art. Some files also contain condition reports and photographs.

### Series 8 Newspaper Clippings and Publicity Files, 1964–2019 [boxes 1–4]

Arranged chronologically. This series consists of newspaper clippings and magazine articles relating to the Vogels, their collection and artists in their collection, related exhibitions and publications, and the documentary films *Herb and Dorothy* and *Herb and Dorothy* 50x50.

#### Series 9 Posters and Publicity Materials, 1964–2008 [oversize]

Arranged alphabetically. This series contains posters of several exhibitions that included artists or works of art from the Vogel collection, and promotional materials for the Vogel film documentaries. Some posters are signed by the artist.

#### Series 10 Photographs – Events, 1961–2010 [boxes 1–3]

Arranged chronologically. This series consists of photographic prints, negatives, and 35mm slides of events and trips that the Vogels attended and travelled. Most of the images depict exhibition openings. Some folders include identification on the back of prints and on slide mounts or on a separate sheet.

For conservation purposes photographic prints, negatives, and slides are stored separately. Some photographs in this series have been digitized and are available to researchers.

#### Series 11 Photographs – People and Places, 1950–2004 [boxes 1–5]

Arranged alphabetically. This series consists of photographic prints, negatives, and 35mm slides of the Vogels, family members, friends, and art colleagues, and places the Vogel visited. Most images depict the couple with artists at their apartment or at the artists' studio. Of interest are images of the Vogel apartment with their works of art before the collection was moved to the

National Gallery of Art. Some folders include identification on the back of prints and slide mounts or on a separate sheet.

For conservation purposes photographic prints, negatives, and slides are stored separately. Some photographs in this series have been digitized and are available to researchers.

#### Series 12 Photographs – Works of Art, 1948–2003 [boxes 1–11]

Prints and slides are arranged alphabetically by artist (negatives are unidentified). This series contains photographic prints, negatives, and 35mm slides of works of art owned by the Vogels. Of interest are images of a work of art by Sol LeWitt that the Vogels exchanged for another and was destroyed later by the artist. These may be the only existing images of the destroyed work of art.

For conservation purposes photographic prints, negatives, and slides are stored separately.

#### Series 13 Audiovisual Recordings, 1961–2017 [boxes 1–7]

Arranged alphabetically. This series consists of videocassettes, audiocassette tapes, removable digital media, reels, and other audiovisual recording formats. The recordings depict broadcast coverage and interviews with or about the Vogels, related exhibitions, and artists in their collection. Some interviews are in German.

#### Series 14 Books and Publications, 1965–2018 [boxes 1–5]

Arranged alphabetically by author or title. This series consists of books, journals, magazines, and other published materials relating to the Vogels or works or artists in their collection. Many of the publications were given to the Vogels and include inscriptions inside the cover or a separate note from the author or gift giver.

### Series 15 Paintings by Dorothy and Herbert Vogel, circa 1950–1965 [oversize]

This series consists of 6 paintings by Herb Vogel and 2 paintings by Dorothy Vogel. These non-accessioned, unstretched canvas paintings were created by the Vogels before 1970.

A group of 34 additional paintings by the Vogels was transferred to Bowdoin University, Brenau University, and the Vogel family in 2013. Digital images of this group of donated paintings are available to researchers.
