

The final concert of the Gallery's 1992–1993 season takes place next Sunday, June 27, at 7:00 p.m. Canadian pianist Louis Lortie will play works by Schumann, Brahms, and Liszt. Concerts will resume October 3, 1993, with a performance by the National Gallery Orchestra, George Manos, conductor.

Concerts from the National Gallery are broadcast in their entirety at 7:00 p.m. on Sundays on radio station WGTS, 91.9 FM, four weeks after the live performance. The use of cameras or recording equipment is not allowed.

Selections from recent Gallery concerts will be rebroadcast on radio station WETA, 90.9 FM, in the context of the program "Music from Washington". The concerts will be aired each Friday in August and September at 9:00 p.m.
