#### Remarks

On 19 February 1924 Stieglitz wrote to J. Dudley Johnston: "My own self-portrait was made 17 years ago" (Royal Photographic Society, Bath, England). This indicates a date of 1907, but he appears older here than in other portraits from 1907 (see *Self-Portrait*, Key Set number 322 and Heinrich Kühn, *Alfred Stieglitz*, 1907, National Gallery of Art, Washington, 1999.76.1). The composition, soft focus, and type of photographic and mounting materials are similar to those of other dated works from 1911.
