NATIONAL GALLERY PRESENTS PIANISTS IN JUNE

Washington, D.C., May 25, 1989 - The National Gallery of Art finishes its current season of Sunday concerts in the West Garden Court by featuring pianists during the month of June. On June 4, piano duettists Dallas Weekley and Nancy Arganbright, a husbandand-wife team, will perform in tandem works by Reger, Mozart, and Mendelssohn. On June 11, Nana Mukhadze, a native of Soviet Georgia who now resides in New York, will perform Schumann's beloved Carnaval, as well as works by Schubert and Debussy. Baltimore pianist Paul Maillet continues the series in a recital of works by Beethoven, Schumann, Ravel, and Mendelssohn on June 18.

The final concert of the season will present the National Gallery Orchestra, George Manos conducting, in a special concert featuring Doriot Anthony Dwyer, principal flautist of the Boston Symphony. The performance includes J. S. Bach's Suite in B Minor for flute and orchestra, as well as orchestral works by Bach and Beethoven.

All concerts take place in the Gallery's West Garden Court, beginning promptly at 7:00 p.m. Seating for the free concerts begins at 6:00 p.m. on a first-come, first-served basis. concerts are broadcast live on WGMS 570 AM and 103.5 FM.
