## ADVANCE PASSES FOR "VAN GOGH'S VAN GOGHS" NO LONGER AVAILABLE SAME-DAY PASSES AVAILABLE BEGINNING OCTOBER 4 AT NATIONAL GALLERY

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- All advance passes to <u>Van Gogh's Van Goghs: Masterpieces from</u> <u>the Van Gogh Museum, Amsterdam</u>, on view at the National Gallery of Art, October 4, 1998 – January 3, 1999, have been distributed. Beginning October 4, a limited number of same-day passes will be available free of charge every day the exhibition is open. They may be obtained on a first-come, first-served basis during public hours at the West Building pass desk, located in the Rotunda on the main floor. There is a limit of six passes per person.

The National Gallery, located on the National Mall at Fourth Street and Constitution Avenue, N.W., is open Monday–Saturday, 10–5, and Sunday, 11-6. The Gallery is closed December 25 and January 1. Admission is free.
